





A life jacket is the most important piece of safety equipment a

paddler can have, but it cannot work if it is not worn. Be ready

for unexpected circumstances and always wear a life jacket when

extremely rough conditions which are impossible to navigate. Poor conditions caused by strong tidal currents, wind, or severe weather can worsen suddenly and without warning. Kayaks designed for sea conditions are recommended and paddlers should carry all appropriate safety gear. Kayaks and canoes are very difficult for other mariners to see and it is the paddler's responsibility to remain alert for power-boats and other watercraft. Ocean-going ships and tugboats with barges navigate a winding shipping channel marked by red and green buoys. Avoid the channel, or cross it at right angles if necessary.
